Workshop on Race and Racism in Health Care and Social Services

Participants will use case scenarios, discussions, and activities to explore race and racism in the context of supporting members while handling grievances, workplace issues and occupational health, and safety concerns.

Participants will:

- Learn language, definitions and key concepts of anti-racism, and racial justice.
- Examine Whiteness, white fragility, and how they maintain systemic racism.
- Understand the four levels of racism and use case studies to explore them.
- Develop personal skills to confront racism and respond when witnessing it.
- Examine how to apply an anti-racist lens to address systemic issues within organizations.

The workshop will be led by two experienced facilitators who have provided training and consultations to numerous organizations and unions and spoken in the media.
