## Dear Andrea Davis:

Thank you for your letter sent on March 5, 2020, to the Honourable Carole James, Minister of Finance expressing your concerns regarding fair working conditions and pay for the Community Social Services Sector. Your letter has been sent to the Public Sector Employers' Council Secretariat for response.

As you will know, government has established programs that recognize the frontline workers providing critical public services in health, social services and corrections to those most vulnerable during the pandemic, including those represented by the Community Social Services Bargaining Association.

On March 20, 2020, the Ministry of Children and Families informed the sector that they would provide incremental funding to support contracted service providers experiencing increased costs due to staff shortages, increased overtime and/or increased demand as a result of COVID-19.

As well, government announced the Temporary Pandemic Pay program, which is a cost shared program with the federal government to provide a \$4/hr temporary pay top-up for eligible workers in the community social service sector. To qualify, workers, including casual and on-call workers, must have been working straight-time hours anytime during the 16-week period that began on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. They must have been working in an <u>eligible sector</u>, <u>workplace and role</u> delivering in-person, front-line care in health, social services and corrections that is listed at <u>www.gov.bc.ca/pandemicpay</u>.

Additionally, government initiated the BC Emergency Benefit for Workers. This program will provide a one-time \$1,000 payment to those whose ability to work has been affected due to COVID-19. Residents of B.C. who receive the federal Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) are eligible, including those whose employment insurance benefits have expired and qualify for CERB.
