Emergency Health Provider Registry – Welcomes New Registrants

To all health science professional health authority employees who provide direct care to patients/residents/clients:

The Emergency Health Provider Registry (EHPR) supports the registration and deployment of health providers willing to provide vital health services during a local, regional or provincial emergency.

Nurses, allied health professionals, and physicians can join the registry at anytime by calling HealthLink BC (8-1-1). Registrants are asked to provide basic information about their education, qualifications, and availability. All information provided is securely managed and protected by HealthLink BC in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.

During an emergency, the registry will periodically email registrants regarding their availability. Registrants pre-selected for a deployment assignment will be contacted by their Staffing Office or Medical Affairs department, and supervisor approval will be required.
